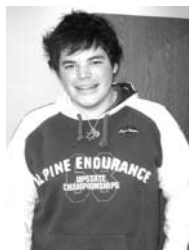
“I have not been back to South Africa in 20 years,” **Uri Goldflam**, Director of the Raphael Recanati International School (RRIS) at the Interdisciplinary Center, Herzliya, (IDC) told **Telfed Magazine** shortly before boarding his flight to Johannesburg. Uri, whose mother was born in South Africa, was about to tour the country, meeting with students and parents, as well as visiting the youth movement summer camps promoting and recruiting. Accompanying him were students **Gadi Cohen** and **Keren Neumann**, both members of **Telfed’s Tzair B’Lev** committee.

“The IDC offers young people in SA an opportunity to receive an excellent education and experience the vibrancy of life in Israel,” says Uri. With a total of 620 students from 48 countries, the RRIS boasts the highest number of students from Western countries than any other programme in Israel.

The School offers four degrees in English, namely: Business Administration, Computer Science & IT Management, Government, Diplomacy & Strategy and Communication.

Telfed Magazine spoke to a few South African students who had only been in Israel a few months.

Romi Gershoni switched from RAU to the IDC last year. “There is no comparison. At RAU we were 650 students in a class. Here we are 40. The personal attention is amazing,” says this first year Business student, whose parents, both Israeli, live in Johannesburg. She breaks into a broad smile when asked about the social scene. “Most of my friends have travelled all over the world but so few have visited Israel. They don’t realize this is such an amazing, fun place. It’s hard to describe; they need to be here to understand.”

Neil Margolis a 20-year old from Johannesburg was “fed up with *affirmative action*.” He recounts that he received nearly double the required points to study law at RAU and was turned away - “‘We’re full,’ was their lame explanation. That’s what’s happening in SA these days.” However, “no regrets” says Neil who is studying at the School of Government. “They did me a favour. The standard is so much higher here.” Feeling more and more like home, Neil reveals “I have started playing rugby for Raanana. All I now have to do is get fit.”

Solly Yellin (ז"ל)

It is with a deep feeling of personal privilege that I write this tribute to the late Solly Yellin, who died in Israel at the age of 95. I had known Solly for more than fifty years, since my involvement with the Zionist movement, the Bnei Zion and the United Zionist Association.

Solly was a community activist, raconteur, and possessor of a prodigious memory - a personality who invariably invoked reaction of one kind or another. There were those who admired the forthrightness of his views, others tended to dismiss them with an air of amusement, and to some he was a source of irritation.

He devoted much of his energy to Jewish and Zionist Education, which had always been close to his heart. He was the last survivor of the founders of the Jewish Day Schools.

He was twice Treasurer and Chairman of the S. A. Board of Jewish Education, as well as being its President. He was Chairman of the UCF, Chairman of the Friends of the Palestine Orchestra and Habima, Chairman of the Institute of Technology of Jerusalem, Convener of the Zionist Luncheon Club, Chairman of the Zionist Record, and for many years Chairman of the South African Zionist Federation Library, where I had the honour to serve with him. He was also a Vice-President of the S.A. Zionist Federation.

A promise Solly made to his father, the last time he saw him before he died at the hands of the Nazis, prompted him to make funds available for the establishment of a Centre of Lithuanian

Jewry at the Ben Gurion University of the Negev in Israel. In January 2001, he received an Honorary Doctorate from the University for his philanthropic contributions. He loved the Yiddish language, was an avid reader and an expert on the holocaust and European Jewish history. He realised his life's ambition and made aliyah in 1999.

Solly influenced many people, young and old. The South African Jewish community will always be indebted to him, for his unstinting devotion to Jewish education. He would often say: "One Jew is responsible for another's education, Jews need teachers, not leaders - leaders are a German idea"

He is survived by his son David, six grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.

Rachel Baron (z"l), 1910 – 2006

Rachel Baron died at the age of 96 in her beloved country, Israel. Born in Johannesburg in 1910, Rachel immigrated to Rhodesia in 1931 following her graduation from Witswaterand University.

Her passion for Israel and Zionism was sparked on a student trip to Europe in 1930. In her words: "The stories told to me by Jewish students were foreboding... of discrimination, humiliations, physical violence... and they turned me into a committed Zionist, convinced that only a Land for the dispersed Jewish people, my people, ISRAEL, could save the Jews from continual persecution."

Rachel's active participation in Zionist affairs began with the formation of the Bulawayo Women's Zionist Society in May 1932. She immediately joined the Committee and later became secretary, then chairman, a position she held several times over the years.

In 1951 she was elected as a delegate to the first World WIZO Conference after World War II, held in Jerusalem. The election was held throughout South Africa and the two Rhodesias. From then on, Rachel continued to be a delegate of Rhodesian Wizo at its world conferences.

In 1952 when Rhodesian WIZO broke away from the South African Women's Zionist Council to form their own Rhodesian Women's Zionist Council, Rachel was elected President, a position she held for twenty-seven years. When she retired, she was elected Honorary Life President.

Rachel was renowned and recognized as a brilliant and inspiring Zionist leader and orator with outstanding organisational abilities and boundless energies.

Since the founding of the State of Israel in 1948 Rachel yearned to live in Israel. She only managed to realize her Zionist dream when she made aliyah in 1994, at the age of 84. For the last six years of her life she lived in Beth Protea. She is survived by her three daughters (Merle Guttman and Beverly Caplan in Israel), nine granddaughters and eighteen great grandchildren, the majority of whom live in Israel.
